David Guy Sadaro, age 73, passed away January 31, 2019 at his home in Mystic , Iowa.

He was born November 2, 1945 in Centerville, Iowa, the son of Guy and Kathleen (Gordon) Sadaro. After graduating from Centerville High School at age 17, David was accepted to Drake University. He worked at HyVee and Owl Drug during the summer months to pay for living expenses.

While at Drake University, David was a member of the American Pharmaceutical Association and the oldest professional pharmacy fraternity in the nation, Kappa Psi. David earned a degree in Pharmacy and Health Sciences in 1968.

David was united in marriage to Patricia L Elarton in 1968. They later welcomed a son, Scott, in 1969 and a daughter, Sally, in 1974.

In 1998, David married Mary Knott with whom he enjoyed travelling and introduced to the great game of golf.
