Jerald Fetters, age 78, of Millerton, passed away Saturday, February 2, 2019. Jerald was born at home in Confidence on October 2, 1940 to Ernest and Irene (Holmes) Fetters. Jerald attended country school through 8th grade and graduated from Corydon High School with the class of 1958. The class celebrated their 60th class reunion in 2018, which he enjoyed. On October 2, 1960 he was united in marriage to Ida Stark at Chariton Methodist Church. To this union came three children: Brad (Becky) Fetters, Craig Fetters and Cindy (Scott) Goolsby. Jerald was a lifelong farmer. He had a great love of the land and enjoyed farming to the fullest and raising sheep. He was a 4H leader during his kids' school days. He coached baseball and attended all sporting events the kids were involved in. He always enjoyed going to the Millerton Caf, having coffee with all the neighbors.
