Clyde Maletta, age 55, of Unionville, Missouri, formerly of Centerville, Iowa, died Tuesday, July 24, 2012 at the Putnam County Hospital, Unionville, MO.

Clyde was born November 7, 1956 in Centerville, Iowa, the son of Lewis and Marguerite (Jean) Breeding Maletta. He was raised in Centerville and graduated from Centerville High School in 1974. Clyde spent his entire life working in the construction field. Most notably, he was skilled in wood fabrication and was known for his abilities as a carpentry finisher. 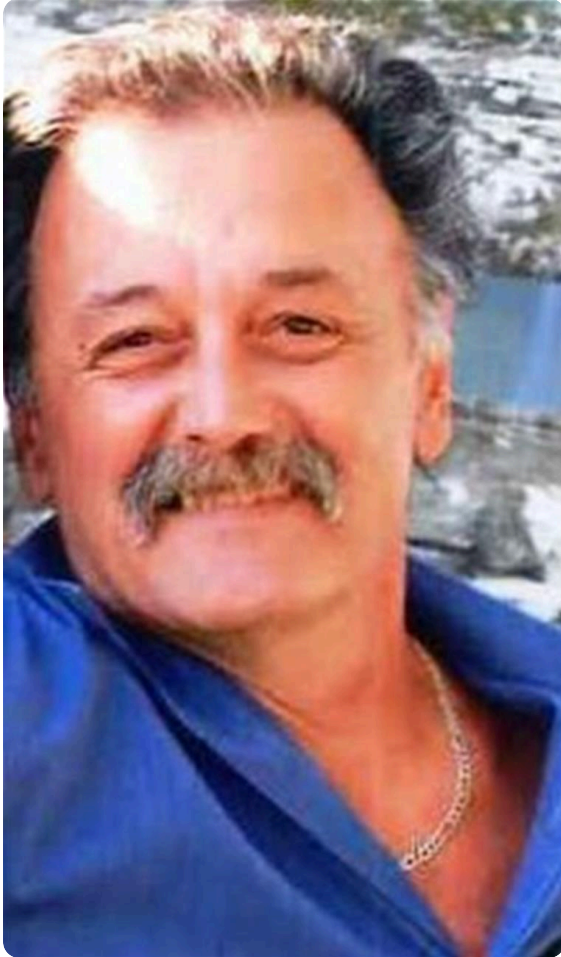
