Her parents moved to Humeston, Iowa when she was in the 3rd grade. She took lessons on her Grandpa Conner's snare drum and played in the school band and after she graduated from Humeston High School in 1943 she worked at the Rouse Drug Store in Humeston until she married. Millie attended the Christian Church in Humeston and was baptized at the age of 14. She sang in the choir and taught a nursery class for a while. She was united in marriage to Cleo J.
