After that, Danny sometimes sent me old bottles that he found in the area. They are still my treasures. We went up to the tri-cities to visit Frances and her family. Helen and Buck were there and Uncle Tony and Aunt Vi came from Chicago. We went to a Croatian bbq that night in the tri-cities and on the way back to Centerville, Danny's car broke down. By then it was about midnight and we had to wait a long time on a lonely, dark road to be rescued! It was that trip that he and my dad introduced me to wild hickory nuts and I loved them! The next Christmas Danny sent me about 4 or 5 pounds of the nuts which he had taken the time to gather, crack, husk, and clean so only the nut meats remained. I still cherish and appreciate the time and thought of that wonderful and delicious gift. Such precious memories of a kind and loving (and sometimes stubborn) soul.
