C yrena Irene Crow, 84, of Centerville, Iowa passed away Wednesday, November 26, 2003 at Mercy Medical Center in Centerville.

She was born in Centerville on November 20, 1919 the daughter of Taylor McCoy and Iva (Swan) McCoy. She was raised in Centerville and received her childhood education at Eureka and Exline Schools, graduating from Centerville High School in 1938.

She was united in marriage to Charley Virgil Crow on April 8, 1939. He preceded her in death on May 1, 1986.
