Maxine Deloris Ahee, age 70 of Unionville, Iowa passed away Monday, April 12, 2021 at her home.

Maxine was born on September 15, 1950 in Albia, Iowa at Monroe County Hospital, the daughter of Max DeWayne and Esther (Shirley) Fisher. She graduated from Blakesburg High School, and continued her education at Marshalltown Community College, graduating as an LPN. On May 18, 1968, Maxine was united in marriage to Michael Gene Ahee.
