## **Ronnie 'Red' Dean Coffman**

**R**onnie Dean "Red" Coffman, age 65, of Moravia, Iowa, passed away Friday, October 12, 2018 at Ridgewood Specialty Care in Ottumwa, Iowa.

Red was born on December 29, 1952 in Davenport, Iowa, the son of Plaz and Mammie May (Hall) Coffman. He graduated from Davenport Central High School with the Class of 1970.

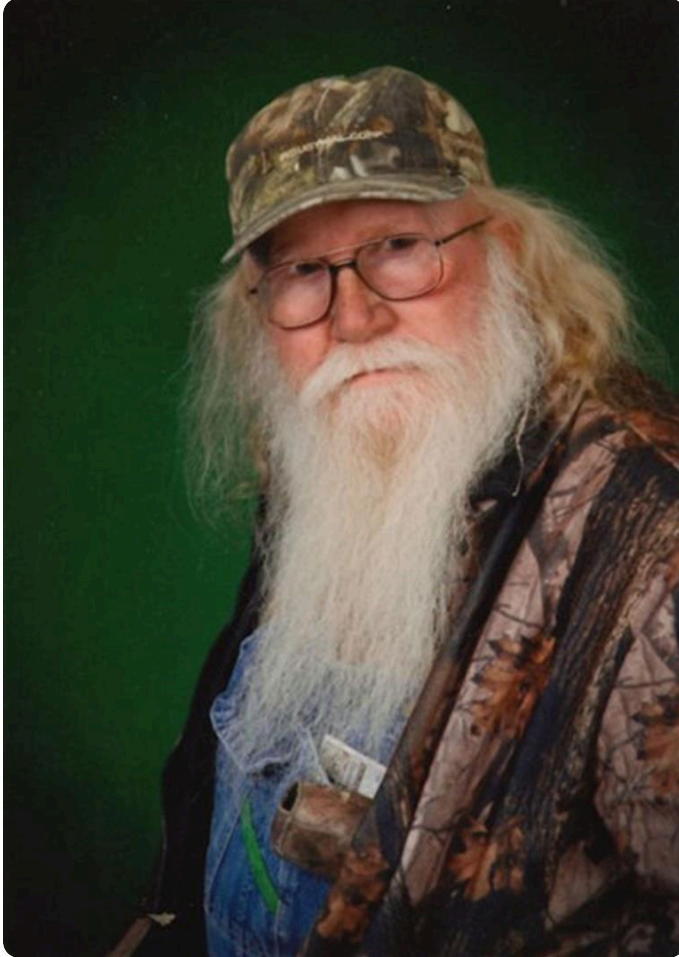
