Richard Allen Strickler Sr., age 66 of Centerville died Friday, January 10, 2014 at Fountain West Nursing Home, West Des Moines, Iowa. He was born April 24, 1947 in Centerville, Iowa, the son of Raymond and Velma (Herrold) Strickler. Richard received his education from Centerville Schools. After graduating from high school he entered the United States Army. Richard served his country faithfully, including a tour of duty in Vietnam. He married Judith Cowan July 17, 1970 in Plano, Iowa. Upon his discharge from the Army, Richard returned home and enrolled at Lincoln Technical, an institution of higher learning that teaches vocational programs. Richard worked for numerous business entities throughout his years of employment, including John Deere, Union Carbide and several local businesses as a mechanic.
