Joe Murphy, age 88, of Centerville, Iowa passed away, Tuesday, May 10, 2016 at Golden Age Care Center in Centerville.

He was born on May 12, 1927 in Exira, Iowa, the son of Thomas and Frances (Voss) Murphy. Joe graduated from Exira High School at the age of sixteen.

Joe was united in marriage to Mary Louise Graham on September 24, 1949 in Hiawatha, Kansas. To this union of marriage three children were born, Patric, Michael, and Pamela. Mary passed away on March 14, 2013.

In his early adult life Joe farmed in Adair County, Iowa and also did construction for a period of time. In 1960, Joe accepted a position as a park ranger with the Iowa Department of Natural Resources. His first assignment was at Pammel State Park in Winterset, Iowa. Later, he and his family moved to Lake Darling State Park in Brighton, Iowa followed by Lake of Three Fires State Park in Bedford, Iowa. In 1970, Joe took the position as park ranger at Honey Creek State Park near Moravia, Iowa, where he worked until his retirement from the park service in 1986.

Joe then kept busy creating woodworking items for Mary's shop and doing various other jobs around Centerville. Joe and Mary decided that they were ready to retire, and relocated to Branson, Missouri. Upon relocating, he did not accept retirement, and took a position with the Compton Ridge Campground where he worked for the next twelve years. He subsequently worked at Silver Dollar City for five years.

Throughout their time as residents in Branson, Missouri, Joe and Mary owned and operated the Hummingbird's Nest Bed and Breakfast.

In 2006, Joe accepted retirement and the couple returned to Centerville. After returning, he attended the First Baptist Church with Mary, volunteered at the New Hope Counseling Center and enjoyed his free time.

Joe was a very devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. His family was very special and treasured by him. Joe and Mary loved to host family
