# Halcyone I. Streepy

DEC 21, 1914 - DEC 30, 2007

**H**alcyone Streepy, age 93 of Des Moines, Iowa died Sunday evening, December 30, 2007 at University Park Nursing Home in Des Moines.

Halcyone was born December 21, 1914, the daughter of Markus and Mary (Ervin) Moriarty in Cincinnati, Iowa. She married Arthur Streepy in January of 1937 in Memphis, Missouri. He preceded her in death in December of 1990.

After graduating from high school, Halcyone took college training in the education field. She spent 14 years teaching in the Appanoose County area. After retiring from teaching, Halcyone spent almost 7 years as a postmaster in Cincinnati, Iowa.

Along with working, Halcyone stayed busy at home, raising her children and helping Arthur with the chores on their farm Northwest of Cincinnati. She enjoyed quilting and reading. Halcyone was a member of the First Christian Church in Cincinnati. During her time as a member, she was a Sunday school teacher at the church.
