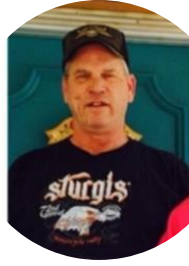

Douglas Carl Ross, age 64, of Centerville, passed away Tuesday, March 31, 2020 at his home.

Douglas was born on February 9, 1956 in Centerville, Iowa, the son of Carl Lee and Shirley (King) Ross.

Following graduation from Centerville High School, Douglas enlisted in the United States Army, and served his country faithfully.
