Agnes Margaret Peel, age 89 of Centerville, went home to be with the Lord on April 16, 2008 at the Golden Age Care Center.

Margaret was born May 3, 1918, the daughter of Noah and Emma Jane (Vestal) Robbins in Cincinnati, Iowa. She grew up in Cincinnati and attended the Cincinnati Schools.

Margaret married Earl Raymond Peel on August 8, 1936 in Centerville, Iowa. He preceded her in death on March 30, 2005.
