Enid Ellen Dixon Kirby died Saturday, November 17, 2018 at Southern Hills Specialty Care in Osceola, Iowa.

Enid was born September 20, 1931 in Davis County, Iowa, the daughter of Frances Ellen Alexander Dixon and Jesse Olen Dixon. She married Bert Neal Kirby on December 24, 1948 in Mystic, Iowa. Enid worked at St. Joseph Hospital for a short time, then worked as School Board Secretary of Moulton-Udell Community Schools for 26 years, retiring in 1996.

Enid was a hard worker and helped her husband on the farm until his death in 2003. In her early years, she and Bert enjoyed square dancing.
