Everette Hornaday, age 87 of Centerville, IA, formerly of Numa, Iowa died Saturday morning, November 8, 2008 at Mercy Medical Center, Centerville. He was born August 31, 1921 at Unionville, IA the son of Everett and Maude (Sharpneck) Hornaday.

He was raised in Eddyville, Iowa where he graduated from high school in 1941 and served in the Navy Seabees in the Pacific Theatre during WWII. He built the airstrip on Iwo Jima and watched the US flag being raised. He married Hazel Hayes February 15, 1947 at the First Baptist Church in Centerville by Pastor Luther Childs.

They were married at 4 PM and left the wedding to go to the farm where Everett needed to milk his cows and Hazel fried him a hamburger- that was their honeymoon. They farmed near Seymour first and later near Centerville, he was also a carpenter. From 1971 until 1980 he operated the Clark Station on the corner of Hwy's 2 & 5 in Centerville.

He and Hazel loved to square dance, in fact they had met a dance. He was a member of the Seymour American Legion and Grace Tabernacle Baptist Church.
