**M**abel Phillips, age 99 of Centerville, Iowa, passed away January 18, 2010 at Mercy Medical Center in Centerville, Iowa.

Mabel was born April 30, 1910, the daughter of Hiram and Hallie (West) Clark in Hawkins Valley in Cincinnati, Iowa. She attended a private catholic school. In 1933 Mabel received Instructions, Baptism and First Communion from Father Murphy at the old St. Mary's Church.

She graduated from Badger Academy of Cosmetology and Mount Sini School of Nursing in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. On December 27, 1947 Mabel was united in marriage to Jack Phillips. He preceded her in death on March 2, 1993.
