Billy Lee Herrick, age 83 of Centerville, passed away Thursday, July 21, 2022 at his home surrounded by family.

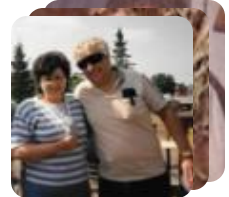

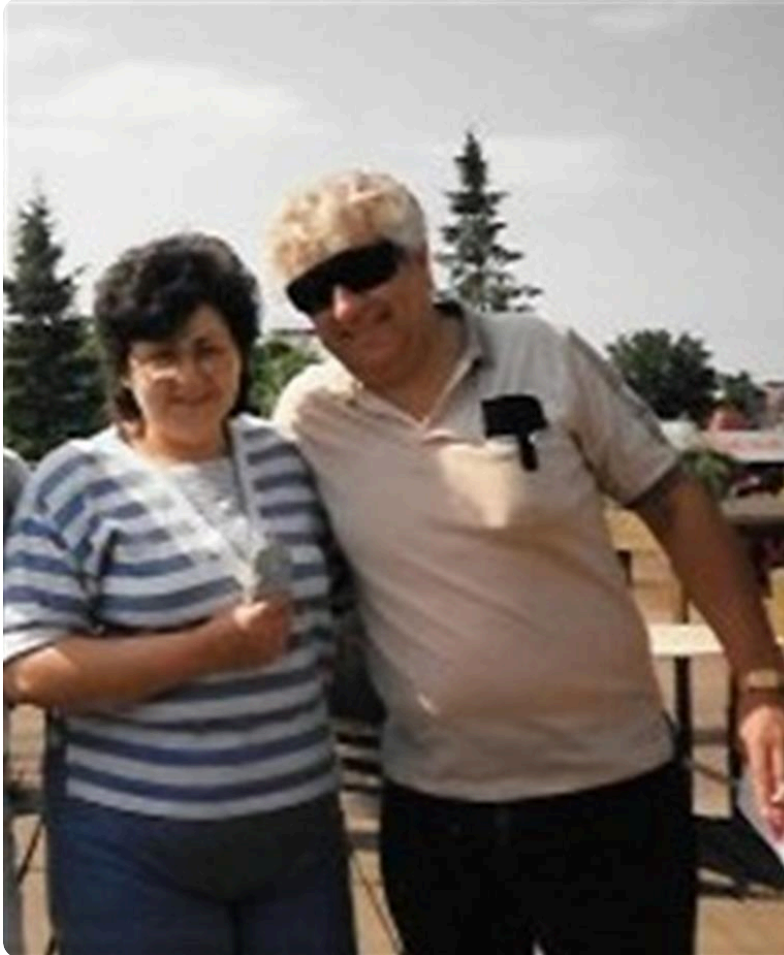

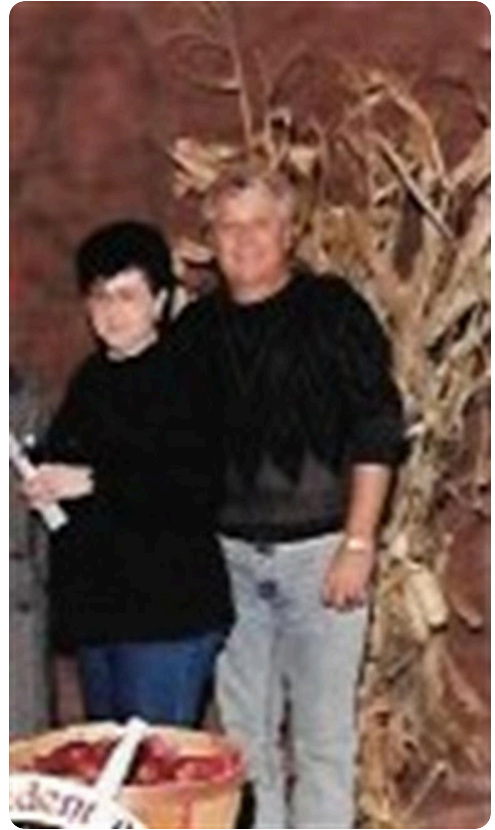
