Wayne H. Roe, 87, passed away peacefully Tuesday, June 1, 2010, at the Wayne County Hospital in Corydon.

Services will be held Friday, June 4, at the Randolph Funeral Home in Allerton, with interment in the Allerton Cemetery.

Wayne was born near Humeston, Iowa, to William and Olive Roe on May 20, 1923. He graduated from Humeston High School at the age of 16.

He went to San Diego to work in an aircraft factory for a few years, and then joined the Army Air Force. He became a navigator and flight officer after attending the cadet school.

Wayne served in WWII and was stationed in England, where he flew a B-17. He was briefly married and had a daughter.

In 1949, Wayne was divorced and therefore returned to Iowa to find a job. A year later, he met his "dear wife," Rosemary Frampton, at the Chariton roller skating rink in 1950.

He always said "it was love at first sight." They married that November at the Humeston Methodist Church and were blessed with three children.

Wayne was actively involved with the Methodist church and the community. He retired in June 1983 and enjoyed golfing. He even made a hole-in-one in 2003, on his 80th birthday.

He collected John Deere memorabilia and lanterns, enjoyed old Western movies and loved spending time with his large family and numerous friends.
