Corinne DeVaun (Dold) French, age 89 of Centerville, Iowa passed away peacefully with her family at her bedside on Sunday, January 02, 2011 at Mercy Medical Center in Centerville.

Corinne was born September 22, 1921 in Coppock, IA to Ronald and Elizabeth (Carpenter) Dold. She graduated from Winfield High School and received her teaching certificate from Iowa Wesleyan College. Corinne taught for a few years before being united in marriage to John French in Marsh, IA on November 5, 1942.
