**E**mil Leimkuehler, age 76, of Numa, Iowa died Thursday, August 23, 2007 at his home.

Emil was born July 1, 1931, the son of George and Esther (Burch) Leimkuehler in Mt. Sterling, Missouri. He served in the Korean War for two years after High School. He attended Ebenezer Baptist Church in Fulton, Missouri.
