Edison 'Ed' Kozak, 85 of Centerville, Iowa, died Wednesday, November 27, 2013 in Long term care at Mercy Medical Center in Centerville. He was born on October 1, 1928 in Yankton, South Dakota the son of Joe and Alice(Sparks) Kozak. He was educated in the Yankton, South Dakota School District. Ed and his family lived in Yankton until they moved to Centerville in 1965. Ed was united in marriage to Edna E. Stickler in Yankton, South Dakota; After her death on July 4, 1996, he was united in marriage to Garnet Deahl on March 20, 1999 in West Des Moines, Iowa. She died on November 23, 2007. Ed farmed much of his life in South Dakota and worked at the State Hospital in Yankton as a nurses aid. After he moved to Centerville he worked at the Box Factory, McGraw Edison and retired from Voltmaster in Corydon.
