Dan Condra, 56 of Numa passed away Wednesday, February 2, 2011 near Cincinnati, Iowa.

Dan was born to Marvin and Marilyn(Teater) Condra on September 21, 1954 in Centerville. He received his education from Layton High School in Layton, Utah. Dan would continue his education at Westminster College in Salt Lake City, Utah and Weber State University in Ogden, Utah.

He was married to Teresa Condra of Hooper, Utah and would later divorce. He married Loree Smith on July 24, 1992. Dan was a farmer and owned Condra Transport. He was a member of Eagle Scouts.
