## **Roy "Gene" Glenn**

JUL 7, 1922 - MAR 9, 2014

**R**oy Eugene Glenn, age 91 years, 8 months and 2 days, of Plano, Iowa, died at his home near Plano on Sunday, March 9, 2014.

He was born July 7, 1922 to Roy and Rachel (Stoner) Glenn northwest of Seymour, Iowa. Gene graduated from Promise City High School in 1939 and became a member of the United Methodist Church in Centerville, Iowa in 1944.

Gene married Elizabeth (Betty) King of Centerville, Iowa, in 1945 and lived on a farm North of Promise City, Iowa. To this union two children were born, a daughter, Mary Ann and a son, John.

Betty and Mary Ann were tragically killed in a car-train accident in the summer of 1953. Gene married Joann Jones of Plano, Iowa, on November 21, 1954. They later moved to a farm near Plano, to this union four children were born, Tim, Danny, Kimberly and Cheryl.

Gene was a wonderful husband and father and truly enjoyed his family. Gene's other enjoyments in life were farming and raising livestock, especially cattle. He enjoyed driving his John Deere tractors and combines.

In his earlier years Gene enjoyed roller skating and dancing, which he learned from his three older sisters. Gene participated in bowling leagues in Centerville and Corydon into his 80's. He enjoyed his Promise City class reunions and attending his children's sporting events.

Gene was very dedicated to the agricultural profession, receiving the Outstanding Conservation Farmer award in 1992 and the Distinguished Farm Family Award. Gene was the leader for Johns Junior Feeder 4-H Club for many years.

Gene was a quiet, soft spoken man who believed in God. He suffered two strokes, but rarely complained. Gene enjoyed taking drives with Joann to see his farm and cattle.
