Edra Mae Robinson passed away surrounded by family, on January 30, 2012 at Mercy Hospital in Des Moines, Iowa.

She was born on September 5, 1928 to Charles and Bertha (Ola) Whicker in Appanoose County Iowa. On July 24, 1945 she was united in marriage to DeWayne Robinson. Her life's work was homemaker and mother of seven until 1973 when DeWayne passed away. At that time she bought Angel's CafAC. in Moravia and ran it very successfully throughout the 70's. In 1980 she became the head cook at the Moravia Junior/Senior High School where she became known as Grandma Edra to hundreds of kids. She is most famous to all for her caramel cinnamon rolls and serving the ""World's Biggest"" tenderloins at her cafAC..

After retiring from the Moravia Schools she continued to cook for various community and school events and also catered many weddings in the area. Edra's passions in life were her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. She enjoyed going to their sporting events, rodeos, and car races. She set aside a day regularly for a ""Girl's Day Out"" that she spent with her four daughters and granddaughters. She enjoyed attending concerts and playing penny slots at the Lakeside Casino in Osceola with her family.
