Larry Milton Sedgwick, age 75, of Exline, Iowa, died Tuesday, May 6, 2014, at Continental at St. Joseph in Centerville, Iowa.

He was born the son of Theodore M. and Ocie (Cousins) Sedgwick on September 15, 1938 in Jerome, Iowa. He attended Centerville Community Schools.
