Lois Cridlebaugh, age 94, of Centerville, passed away Saturday, August 28, 2021 at MercyOne Medical Center, Long Term Care in Centerville.

Lois was born on September 8, 1926 in Centerville, Iowa, the daughter of Vernon George and Alma (Hanson) Marshall. She graduated from Centerville High School with the Class of 1944. On May 16, 1948, Lois was united in marriage to Raymon C. "John" Cridlebaugh at the Cridlebaugh farm near Udell, Iowa. To this union, three children were born, Alma Kaye, Gary, and Kathy.

After high school, Lois taught Country Schools for several years. Once Lois and John got married, she stopped teaching and the couple farmed for over 40 years in the Udell area before moving to Centerville. During this time, she also worked at HyVee in Centerville for 20 years in the Produce Department.

Lois enjoyed needlework, especially sewing and gardening. She was a dedicated member of the Mt. Ararat Baptist Church, east of Centerville, and read her Bible every day. She was also a member of the MercyOne Hospital Auxiliary, and loved volunteering at the hospital.
