## Larry Wendland

Larry Dean Wendland, 80, of Moulton, passed away on March 28, 2021 at MercyOne Medical Center in Centerville. Larry was born on May 16, 1940 in Moulton to Trenton and Pearlene (Dixon) Wendland. Larry attended school at Moulton-Udell before leaving to help out on the family farm. He joined the United States Army in 1966 and proudly served his country for several years before being honorably discharged. Upon release, he did industrial work and drove semi-trucks before owning and operating his own paint company up until his retirement. Larry was united in marriage to Callie Knapp in 1973 and shared 25 wonderful years together until her passing. He was an avid hunter and fisherman and also enjoyed coaching baseball, playing cards, collecting coins and spending time with his family.
