## Earl Dean Mattly

FEB 28, 1931 - JUN 9, 2018

**E**arl Dean Mattly, age 87, of Pleasant Valley, Iowa, formerly of Seymour, passed away Saturday, June 9, 2018 at Riverview Manor in Pleasant Valley.

Dean was born on February 28, 1931 in Bethlehem, Iowa, the son of Tell Martin and Mary Agnus (Foster) Mattly. On May 19, 1950, he was united in marriage to Donna L. Smith of Promise City. He later married Rose Ann Garvin on July 30, 1974 in Moline, Illinois.

In 1951, Dean moved to the Quad Cities to work at Farmall Tractor Works as a laborer. Six months later, he entered into the Navy. After serving his country faithfully for four years, he returned to Rock Island, Illinois, and attended an Apprenticeship program provided by Farmall Tractor Works, and became an electrician.

He worked there for 30 years until his retirement in 1981. Upon retirement, he decided to move to Seymour, Iowa. He drove a school bus for Seymour Schools for ten years. Dean's love and passion was wiring houses for his family and friends.

He was a vivid hunter and fisherman, and he was also very fond of Appaloosa horses. He was a member of the Plano Methodist Church for many years. Dean was a fan of the St. Louis Cardinals.
