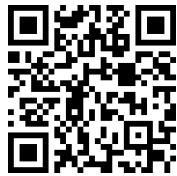

Billy Joe Mattly, son of Tell and Mary Agnes (Foster) Mattly, was born April 26, 1938 at the family farm outside of Promise City. He departed life on March 10, 2013 at the Continental Care Center in Seymour.
