Kenneth Irvin DeVore, 85, of Corydon, passed away peacefully in his home Saturday, October 31, 2020. Kenneth was born to Leonard and Edra (Mead) DeVore on December 23, 1934 in Seymour, Iowa. He attended Seymour High School and graduated in 1952. He was united in marriage to Dorothy Colleen Hibbs December 28, 1954. They were married 53 years until Dorothy's death in November 2007. From this union five children were born, Kathy, Kristen, Dorine, Denise, Martin. Kenneth and Dorothy lived on their farm south of Seymour for most of their years of marriage. Kenneth was active in the Seymour Christian Church, serving as Deacon, Elder, Trustee, and Board Chairman. He especially enjoyed cooking Easter morning breakfasts for his fellow parishioners. Kenneth served for the Iowa National Guard in 113th Armored Unit Red Bull 34th Division from 1953 - 1963, obtaining the rank of Staff Sergeant. He was also a member of the Seymour American Legion.
