William 'Ted' Theodore Evans, 79 of Numa passed away Saturday, October 18, 2008 at his home in Numa.

Ted was born on March 8, 1929 to Orin & Helen (Schmeichert) Evans in Lancaster, Missouri. He received his education from Lancaster High School in 1948. Ted married Joanne Anderson on September 11, 1954. She preceded him in death on May 28, 1993. He would later marry Velma Atkinson on June 28, 2003.

Ted was a veteran of the United States Army. He served in the 7th Recon, 7th Division Infantry during the Korean War. Ted was a member of Numa American Legion Post #726, VFW Post #526, Cincinnati Masonic Lodge #504, AMVETS and Centerville Eagles Aerie #2675.
