Floyd Robb, 75 of Centerville, passed away on October 17, 2021 at Mercy One Hospital in Des Moines, Iowa.

Floyd was born on August 29, 1946 to Raymond Floyd and Halena (Ross) Robb in Centerville, Iowa. Floyd graduated from Abraham Lincoln High School in Des Moines. Floyd served in the Vietnam War.
