Letha Crawford, 92 of Centerville passed away, Wednesday, March 9, 2022 at Mercy One - Centerville.

She graduated from high school in Moulton IA. After high school she worked at the KRNT theater and was a model for Yonkers in Des Moines. Letha married Jack Crawford on June 27, 1948.
